As we start into the last of the chapter's calendar year I hope everyone has committed themselves to participating in as many events and activities as possible. Before we talk about that, I would

like to pass along some very good news.

Compatriot David Gammon represented us at the Summer Board of Managers meeting in Hickory and accepted several awards the chapter received at the National Congress.

We received the Small Chapter (1-49 mbrs.) Liberty Bell Award in recognition of the chapter's participation in outreach education efforts and acknowledgement of community leaders for their efforts to perpetuate the efforts of the SAR. This is the first time we have received this prestigious award for Americanism.

The next award was the President-General's Cup for Small Chapters (1-49 mbrs.). This award recognizes the chapter that best achieves the goals of both the President-General's and Americanism Awards. This is the second time we have received this award (2013) for the best overall program in the nation.

The chapter received its 9th Partners in Patriotism certificate for joining with veterans groups in sponsoring events such as Memorial Day and Veterans Day ceremonies.

The last award was a star for our Patriot Biographies Streamer.

The July, 2017 meeting of the Halifax Resolves Chapter, NCSSAR, was held on Wednesday, July 12, 2017 at the Halifax Baptist Church in Halifax, NC. President Ken Wilson called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm. An invocation was given by Rev. Duncan Jones, and then all present joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the US Flag. President Wilson led the members in the SAR Pledge.

The President reported on the following:

- at the last National Congress we received the prestigious Liberty Bell Award for small chapters, given to the chapter with the highest scores in publicity, events, grave markings, etc..
- we also received the President General's Cup in the small chapter category, which recognized us as the best small chapter in the country in carrying out the PG's goals. The chapter acknowledged the hard work that Ken put into these awards with a round of applause.

Albemarle Chapter President and District VP Chris Grimes then gave a most interesting and informative presentation on Edward Buncombe, who was Col. of the 5th NC Regiment. He was a prominent landowner in Tyrrell County before the Revolution and led the 5th NC at the battles of Brandywine Creek and Germantown, where he was wounded and captured by the British, later dying of these wounds.

President Wilson then led the members in the SAR Recessional, Rev. Duncan Jones gave the benediction, and the meeting was adjourned at 8:00.




